By opinion A.G.O. 073-377 (October 8,1973), the Attorney General construed Section 104.36, Florida Statutes, <u>not</u> to prohibit commercial or other activities not specifically proscribed in and by the statute.

Accordingly, such activity as you describe is not prohibited.
