**Convicted Felon's Voting Rights
Chapter 98, Florida Statutes**

You ask whether a convicted felon, adjudicated as such and sentenced, but with an appeal now pending, may vote.

Section 98.313, Florida Statutes, requires the supervisor to remove from the registration books the names of convicted felons upon the list of same being furnished to the supervisor pursuant to Section 98.312, Florida Statutes.

Only qualified electors may vote.

Your question is therefore, answered accordingly.
