You have asked whether a lapel sticker might be handed without charge to people upon their departure from the polls, said sticker being substantially in the following form:

By opinion A.G.O. 073-377 (October 8, 1973), the Attorney General construed Section 104.36, Florida Statutes, not to prohibit commercial or other activities not specifically proscribed in and by the statute.

Accordingly, such activity as you describe is not prohibited.
